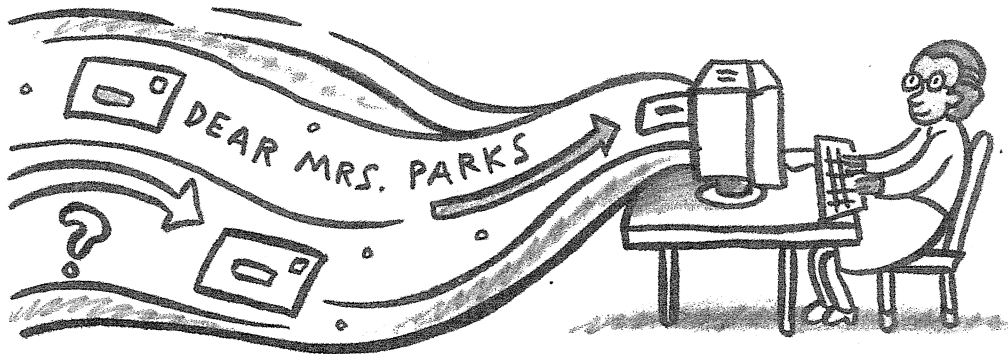


Skill Reminder
