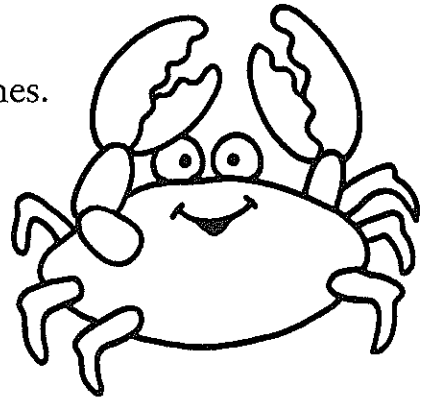


Skill Reminder • A **singular noun** names one person, animal, place, or thing.
