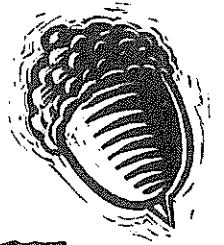

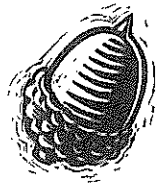

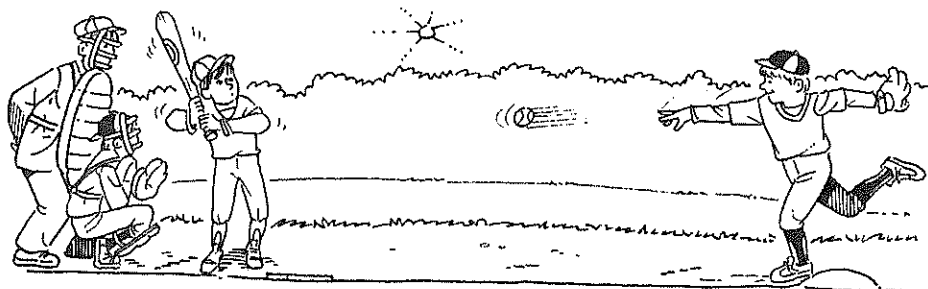
# Draw Conclusions
